
# ORGANIZATION & ACCOMMODATION

### PRICE AND REGISTRATION



Interdisciplinary creativity process and contribution of design thinking

#### OBJECTIVES AND THEME OF THE AUTUMN CAMP

This autumn camp aims to create an Ephemeral Living lab for 4 days on the design thinking of multimedia selflearning systems. ARCHIMEDE Living Lab is one of the three autumn camps of Lille World Design Capital.

ARCHIMEDE Living Lab's originality lies in the participation of students, people in activity, project leaders, researchers, engineers, entrepreneurship, experts from the Hautsde-France french region, Europe and from Africa joining to work together.

ARCHIMEDE Living Lab will train participants in the self-design method, based on the conceptual thinking approach and tools. The Living Lab Archimede will also be an opportunity to give perspectives and exchanges on the global crisis that the world is currently going through. ARCHIMEDE Living Lab will allow designers, experts, students, researchers, entrepreneurs, etc. to meet in order to co-create multimedia educational applications.

At the end of ARCHIMEDE Living Lab, participants will be trained in the methods of design thinking, in the methods of designing educational content and in digital tools for designing multimedia learning systems.

ARCHIMEDE Living Lab is open to anyone wishing to train on digital multimedia design methods with the contribution of design thinking (Entrepreneur, students, engineer, researcher, project holder incubated or in the process of incubation, professor. ARCHIMEDE Living Lab will create a multicultural environment in which participants from different countries will brainstorm. ARCHIMEDE Living Lab will be hold in French and in English.
